ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A27 Trunk Road (Dittons North Roundabout) (Temporary
40 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2010**

Made - - - - - *23rd August 2010*

Coming into force - - - *11th September 2010*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A27 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A27 Trunk Road (Dittons North Roundabout) (Temporary 40 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 11th September 2010.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A27 Trunk Road near Polegate in the County of East Sussex;

“the length of trunk road” means the trunk road from a point 355 metres east of the eastern edge of Dittons North roundabout (A22 – Golden Jubilee Way) to, and including, that roundabout;

“works” means carriageway widening work on the trunk road; and

“the works period” means the period starting on Monday 13th September 2010 and ending on 10th March 2012.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes.
