ROAD TRAFFIC

The M5 Motorway (Junction 14 – Junction 13, Michael Wood Services) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010

Made - - - - 24 August 2010

Coming into force - - 28 August 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M5 Motorway (“the M5”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and one of those connecting roads between Junction 14 and Junction 13 in the County of Gloucestershire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M5 Motorway (Junction 14 – Junction 13, Michael Wood Services) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 28 August 2010.

2. In this Order –

“the slip roads” means;

- (a) the northbound entry and exit slip roads at Michael Wood Services;
- (b) the southbound entry and exit slip roads at Michael Wood Services;

“the works” mean replacement of carriageway markings and road studs;

“the works period” means the period starting at 22.00 hours on Wednesday 1 September 2010 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip roads.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

(c) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
