ROAD TRAFFIC

The M2 Motorway (Junction 1, Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010

Made - - - - *31st August 2010*

Coming into force - - *18th September 2010*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M2 Motorway and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on some of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed on and near the road:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M2 Motorway (Junction 1, Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 18th September 2010.

2. In this Order:

“the motorway” means the M2 Motorway at Junction 1 in the County of Kent;

“a slip road” means –

- (i) the road leading from the Londonbound carriageway of the motorway to the A289 at Junction 1 (A2), or
- (iii) the road leading from the A289 to the coastbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 1 (A2);

“works” mean street lighting repair work on and near the motorway; and

“a works period” means a period of 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Tuesday 21st September 2010 or on any subsequent day until 17th March 2012.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;

- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
