ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A35 Trunk Road (Bridport Bypass)
(Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2010**

Made - - - - - *31 August 2010*

Coming into force - - - *4 September 2010*

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A35 Trunk Road (“the A35”), is satisfied that traffic on a lengths of that road at Bridport in the District of West Dorset, in the County of Dorset should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon.

NOW THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the A35 Trunk Road (Bridport Bypass) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 4 September 2010.

2. In this Order -

“the first length of the A35” means the westbound carriageway of the A35 from a point 5 metres east of the centre of its junction with the B3162 to a point 15 metres west of the centre of its junction with West Bay Road, a total distance of 2,564 metres;

“the second length of the A35” means the eastbound carriageway of the A35 from a point 15 metres east of the centre of its junction with West Bay Road to a point 5 metres west of the centre of its junction with the B3162, a total distance of 2,564 metres;

“the works” means surface treatment carriageway and barrier works;

“the works period” means the period starting at 00.01 hours on 6 September 2010 and ending when the said works have been completed;

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 6 September 2010 or on any subsequent night and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to an article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall:

(i) during the works period drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the first length of the A35;

(ii) during a works period drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on the first length of the A35 whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under

section 64 of the Road traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that road are displayed.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the second length of the A35.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable in uniform.

6. The provisions of article 4 shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for traffic officer purposes;
- (c) a vehicle proceeding to or from premises that are accessible from and only from the second length of the A35.
