ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A12 Trunk Road (Junction 19 Boreham Interchange,
Chelmsford, Essex) Northbound Exit Slip Road (Temporary
Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010**

Made - - - - - *6 September 2010*

Coming into force - - - - - *13 September 2010*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A12 Trunk Road (“the A12”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads in the District of Chelmsford in the County of Essex should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon and nearby:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A12 Trunk Road (Junction 19 Boreham Interchange, Chelmsford, Essex) Northbound Exit Slip Road (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 13 September 2010.

2. In this Order:

“the slip road” means the A12 northbound exit slip road at Junction 19 Boreham Interchange;

“works” mean road marking and sign installation works;

“a works period” means a period of 8 1/2 hours starting at 21.00 hours on Monday 20 September 2010 or on any subsequent day until the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works or for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes, or proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
