**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A35 Trunk Road (Deep Cut, Between Axminster and Honiton) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2010**

*Made* - - - - - *8 September 2010*

*Coming into force* - - - *11 September 2010*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A35 Trunk Road (“the A35”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road between Axminster and Honiton in the District of East Devon in the County of Devon should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A35 Trunk Road (Deep Cut, Between Axminster and Honiton) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 11 September 2010.

2. In this Order –

“the A35” means the A35 between Axminster and Honiton from a point 200 metres west of the centre of its junction with the B3181 to a point 40 metres west of the centre of its junction with Colhayne Lane;

“the works” mean carriageway resurfacing, kerb works and barrier renewal;

“the works period” means the period starting at 00.01 hours on Monday 13 September 2010 and ending when the said works have been completed;

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 13 September 2010 or any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour in the A35 whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that road are displayed.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the A35.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable.
