**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A2070 Trunk Road (Hamstreet) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010**

*Made* - - - - *13th September 2010*

*Coming into force* - - *2nd October 2010*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A2070 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted on a length of that road and prohibited on one of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A2070 Trunk Road (Hamstreet) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 2nd October 2010.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A2070 Trunk Road in the County of Kent;

“the length of trunk road” means both carriageways of the trunk road between points 1200 metres north of the slip road leading to and from the B2067 (Ashford Road) and 1200 metres south of the B2067 underbridge (Warehorne Road);

“the slip road” means the road leading to and from the trunk road to and from the B2067 (Ashford Road);

“works” mean resurfacing work on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 2000 hours on Monday 4th October 2010 or on any subsequent day until 1st April 2012.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6 below, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding –

(a) 10 miles per hour on the length of trunk road while traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that length of road are displayed; or

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

- (b) 40 miles per hour on the length of trunk road while the traffic signs specified in paragraph (a) of this article in relation to that length of road are not displayed.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. (1) Nothing in article 3 above shall apply to –

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.

(2) Nothing in article 4 above shall apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes.
