ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A50 Trunk Road (Sudbury to Doveridge, Derbyshire)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010**

Made - - - - 17 September 2010

Coming into force - - 24 September 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A50 Trunk Road (“the A50”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road and two of those connecting roads between Sudbury and Doveridge in the County of Derbyshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A50 Trunk Road (Sudbury to Doveridge, Derbyshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 24 September 2010.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means –

(a) the eastbound carriageway of the A50 from its junction with the slip road leading to the A515 interchange near West Broughton to its roundabout junction with the A515 and Aston Lane (Sudbury Roundabout); and

(b) the westbound carriageway of the A50 from its junction with the slip road leading to the A515 interchange near West Broughton to its junction with the slip road leading from Marston Lane at Doveridge;

“a slip road” means –

(a) the slip road leading to the eastbound carriageway of the A50 from the A515 interchange near West Broughton; and

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1

(b) the slip road leading to the westbound carriageway of the A50 from the A515 interchange near West Broughton;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Friday 1 October 2010 and ending when the said works have been completed,

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (c) being used for or in connection with the said works.
