

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 27 September 2010 or any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period:

- (a) drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the first length of the A30;
- (b) cause or permit any vehicle to enter, proceed or remain in the laybys adjacent to the eastbound carriageway of the A30 situated:
 - (i) 1100 metres east of the centre of Innis Down Junction Overbridge;
 - (ii) 350 metres west of the centre of Bible Christian Overbridge;
 - (iii) 750 metres east of the centre of Bible Christian Overbridge;
 - (iv) 950 metres south of the centre of Callywith Junction Overbridge;
 - (v) 300 metres south of the centre of Callywith Junction Overbridge.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the second length of the A30.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable.

6. The provisions of articles 3(b) and 4 shall not apply to a vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works or for traffic officer purposes.
