ROAD TRAFFIC

The A12 Trunk Road (Colemans Bridge, Witham, Essex) (Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010

Made - - - - - *27 September 2010*

Coming into force - - - - - *4 October 2010*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A12 Trunk Road (“the A12”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on some of those other roads in the County of Essex should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A12 Trunk Road (Colemans Bridge, Witham, Essex) (Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 4 October 2010.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during a period of 9 hours starting at 21.00 hours on Monday 11 October 2010 or on any subsequent day until concrete and paint testing works to Colemans Bridge have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A12 northbound exit or southbound entry slip roads leading to and from the B1389 Colchester Road, Witham.

3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, for winter service maintenance, or for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes.
