The M48 Motorway (Greenditch Street Overbridge to Junction 1) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2010 Variation Order 2010

Made - - - - - *29 September 2010*

Coming into force - - - - - *2 October 2010*

The Secretary of State for Transport makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) and (7) of, and paragraph 27(1) of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a):

1. This Order may be cited as the M48 Motorway (Greenditch Street Overbridge to Junction 1) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2010 Variation Order 2010 and shall come into force on 2 October 2010.

2. The M48 Motorway (Greenditch Street Overbridge to Junction 1) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2010(b) is hereby varied by substituting, for the definition “the M48” in article 2, the following definition:

‘ “the M48” means (i) the westbound carriageway of the M48 from a point at the centre of Greenditch Street Overbridge to the tip of the nosing of the westbound exit slip road at Junction 1; and (ii) the eastbound carriageway of the M48 from a point 300 metres west of the tip of the nosing of the eastbound exit slip road at Junction 1 to a point at the centre of Greenditch Street Overbridge;’
