ROAD TRAFFIC

The A21 Trunk Road (Forstal Farm Roundabout – Scotney Castle Roundabout) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010

Made - - - - *25th October 2010*

Coming into force - - *13th November 2010*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A21 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted and prohibited on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A21 Trunk Road (Forstal Farm Roundabout – Scotney Castle Roundabout) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 13th November 2010.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A21 Trunk Road (Lamberhurst By-Pass) near Lamberhurst in the County of Kent;

“the length of trunk road” means both carriageways of the trunk road between points 900 metres north of the River Teise bridge (at Forstal Farm roundabout – A262) and 1041 metres south of Spray Hill overbridge (at Scotney Castle roundabout – B2169);

“works” mean the construction of emergency crossovers on the trunk road;

“a first works period” means a period of 24 hours starting at 0001 hours on Monday 15th November 2010 or on any subsequent day until 12th May 2012; and

“a second works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 2000 hours on Monday 15th November 2010 or on any subsequent day until 12th May 2012.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6 below, no person shall, during a first works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the length of trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6 below, no person shall, during a second works period cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of trunk road.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. (1) Nothing in article 4 above shall apply to –

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.

(2) Nothing in article 3 above shall apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes.
