**The A428 Trunk Road (East of A1/B1428 Great North Road
Roundabout, North of Wyboston, Bedfordshire to B1428
Cambridge Road Roundabout, St Neots, Cambridgeshire)
(Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010**

<i>Made</i> - - - -	<i>25 October 2010</i>
<i>Coming into force</i> - -	<i>1 November 2010</i>

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport being the traffic authority for the A428 Trunk Road (“the A428”), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road in the District of Bedford Borough in the County of Bedfordshire and the District of Huntingdon in the County of Cambridgeshire, should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A428 Trunk Road (East of A1/B1428 Great North Road Roundabout, North of Wyboston, Bedfordshire to B1428 Cambridge Road Roundabout, St Neots, Cambridgeshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 shall come into force on 1 November 2010.

2. In this Order –

“the trunk road” means the A428 from its junction with the B1043 Barford Road (Tesco) Roundabout to its junction with the B1428 Cambridge Road (Tithe Farm) Roundabout;

“lay-by” means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the sign is placed; and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a surface suitable for the exercise of that right;

“works” mean carriageway patching and drainage works to the trunk road;

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 8 November 2010 or on any subsequent day until the said works have been completed;

“the works period” means the period starting at 00:01 hours on Monday 8 November 2010 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the –

- (a) trunk road, during a works period, or
- (b) Oxbow lay-by adjacent to the eastbound carriageway of the A428 situated 1.6 kilometres east of the A1/B1428 Great North Road (The Crown) Roundabout, north of Wyboston, during the works period.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle –

- (a) being used for, or in connection with, the said works or for winter service maintenance or traffic officer purposes,
- (b) being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes, or
- (c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or traffic officer in uniform;
