**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A46 Trunk Road (Warwick Bypass) (Temporary Restriction  
and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010**

*Made - - - - 5 November 2010*

*Coming into force - - 12 November 2010*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road (“the A46”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and one of those connecting roads near Warwick in the County of Warwickshire should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A46 Trunk Road (Warwick Bypass) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 12 November 2010.

2. In this Order –

| “the roundabout”   | means the circulatory carriageway of the A46 at its roundabout junction with the A4177 and A425 (Birmingham Road Roundabout);   |
| “the trunk road”   | means the southbound carriageway of the A46 from its junction with the slip road leading to the roundabout to its roundabout junction with the M40 and A429 at Longbridge ( M40 Junction 15); |
| “the slip road”    | means the slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the A46 from the roundabout;   |
| “the works period” | means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 15 November 2010 and ending when the said works have been completed;   |

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and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding –

- (a) 10 miles per hour on lengths of the trunk road whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on those lengths of road are displayed; or
- (b) 40 miles per hour on a length of the trunk road whilst such traffic signs in relation to that length are not displayed.

**4.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road or the slip road.

**5.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4, shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

**6.** The provisions of –

- (a) articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle –
  - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
  - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; and
- (b) article 4 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the works.
