ROAD TRAFFIC

The A30 Trunk Road (Loggans Moor Roundabout to St Erth Roundabout, Hayle, Cornwall) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010

Made - - - - *10 November 2010*

Coming into force - - *13 November 2010*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A30 Trunk Road (“the A30”), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road near Hayle in Cornwall should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A30 Trunk Road (Loggans Moor Roundabout to St Erth Roundabout, Hayle, Cornwall) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 13 November 2010.

2. In this Order –

“the A30” means the A30 at Hayle from the eastern edge of the St Erth Roundabout to the southern edge of Loggans Moor Roundabout;

“the circulatory carriageway” means the circulatory carriageway at the A30 St Erth Roundabout, Hayle;

“the local road” means the A3074 Nut Lane junction with St Erth Roundabout, Hayle;

“the works” mean resurfacing and associated works;

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 15 November 2010 or any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle:

(a) to enter or proceed in the A30;

(b) to enter or proceed in the circulatory carriageway;

(c) to enter or leave the circulatory carriageway at its junction with the local road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
- (c) a vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works.
