## ROAD TRAFFIC

The A49 Trunk Road (Wistanstow to Strefford, Shropshire) (Temporary 10 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2010

 Made
 22 November 2010

 Coming into force
 29 November 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A49 Trunk Road ("the A49"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road between Wistanstow and Strefford in the County of Shropshire should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A49 Trunk Road (Wistanstow to Strefford, Shropshire) (Temporary 10 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 29 November 2010.

## 2. In this Order –

"the trunk road" means the A49 between its junction with the un-named

road leading to Wistanstow (610 metres north of the A489 junction) and its junction with the un-named road leading

to Strefford;

"the works period" means the period starting at 2000 hours on Monday 6

December 2010 and ending when the said works have

been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on lengths of the trunk road whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating "convoy working" on those lengths of road are displayed.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to any vehicle –
