**The A5 Trunk Road (Tamworth, Staffordshire) (Slip Roads)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010**

Made - - - - 29 November 2010

Coming into force - - 06 December 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road (“the A5”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on three of those connecting roads near Tamworth in the County of Staffordshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Tamworth, Staffordshire) (Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 6 December 2010.

2. In this Order:

“a slip road” means the slip road leading –

- (i) from the eastbound carriageway of the A5 to its roundabout junction with the B5404 Bonehill Road and Plantation Lane (Mile Oak Junction);
- (ii) to the eastbound carriageway of the A5 from its roundabout junction with the B5404 Bonehill Road and Plantation Lane (Mile Oak Junction); and
- (iii) from the eastbound carriageway of the A5 to its roundabout junction with the B5440 Marlborough Way (Glascote Junction);

“the works period” means the period starting at 2100 hours on Monday 13 December 2010 and ending when the said works have been completed,

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes,
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
