ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A12 Trunk Road (Yarmouth Road, Lowestoft, Suffolk)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010**

Made - - - - - *13 December 2010*

Coming into force - - - - - *20 December 2010*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A12 Trunk Road (“the A12”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road in the County of Suffolk should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A12 Trunk Road (Yarmouth Road, Lowestoft, Suffolk) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 20 December 2010.

2. In this Order –

“works” mean carriageway resurfacing, white lining and the upgrading of skid resistant surface on the approaches to the pedestrian crossing near Bellevue Park;

“a works period” means a period of 9 hours starting at 21:00 hours on Tuesday 4 January 2011 or on any subsequent day (other than a Saturday or Sunday), until the works have been completed.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the A12 Yarmouth Road, Lowestoft at its junction with –

- (a) The Ravine,
- (b) North Parade, or
- (c) the B1385 Corton Road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only during such times and such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the works or for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance, traffic officer or winter service maintenance purposes.
