**The A66 Trunk Road (Whinfell Park to Highbarn Lane End
Resurfacing) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic)
Order 2010**

Made - - - - *16 December 2010*

Coming into force - - *9 January 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A66 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road in the District of Eden in the County of Cumbria should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A66 Trunk Road (Whinfell Park to Highbarn Lane End Resurfacing) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 9 January 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A66 Trunk Road;

“the first length of trunk road” means the trunk road from a point 450 metres west of the centreline of the U3193 Lane End Road to a point 350 metres east of the centreline of the same road;

“the second length of trunk road” means the trunk road from a point 245 metres west of the centreline of the U3193 Lane End Road to a point 145 metres east of the centreline of the same road;

“the works period” means four nights between 2000 hours and 0600 hours, starting on Monday 10 January 2011 and ending on Friday 14 January 2011. However works may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue overnight until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

“works” means carriageway resurfacing on the trunk road.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 6 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven in the first length of trunk road at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour.
4. Subject as mentioned in article 6 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven in the second length of trunk road at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under Section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that length of road are displayed.
5. Subject as mentioned in article 6 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to overtake a moving vehicle or make a ‘U’ turn in the second length of trunk road.
6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or traffic officer in uniform.

Nothing in article 5 of this Order shall apply to vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers.
