**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The M69 and M6 Motorways (M6 Junction 2) (Link and Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010**

*Made* - - - - 21 December 2010

*Coming into force* - - 28 December 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M69 Motorway (“the M69”), the M6 Motorway (“the M6”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of those motorways and five of those connecting roads, northeast of Coventry and in the County of Warwickshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The M69 and M6 Motorways (M6 Junction 2) (Link and Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 28 December 2010.

2. In this Order –

“a link road” means the link road –  
i) leading from the eastbound carriageway of the M6 to the northbound carriageway of the M69, between its junction with the M6 and its junction with the slip road leading from the M6 Junction 2 roundabout;  
ii) leading from the southbound carriageway of the M69 to –  
a. the westbound carriageway of the M6 and  
b. the circulatory carriageway of the roundabout;

“a slip road” means the slip roads leading –  
i) to the eastbound carriageway of the M6 at Junction 2;  
ii) to the westbound carriageway of the M6 at Junction 2;  
iii) from the westbound carriageway of the M6 at Junction 2 to its junction with the M69 South/M6 West Link Road;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Tuesday 4 January 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on a link road and or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (c) being used for or in connection with the said works or by a traffic officer in uniform.
