**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The M56 Motorway (Junction 12 Eastbound Exit  
Slip Road)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010**

*Made* - - - - 27 December 2010

*Coming into force* - - 16 January 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M56 Motorway and slip roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those slip roads in the Borough of Halton should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the M56 Motorway (Junction 12 Eastbound Exit Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force 16 January 2011.

2. In this Order;

“the motorway” means the M56 Motorway;

“works” means the installation of a bike guard rail along the existing safety barrier and replacement of traffic signs;

“the works period” means 14 nights between;

- i. 2200 hours and 0500 hours starting in Monday 17 January 2011 and ending on Friday 21 January 2011
- ii. 2200 hours and 0700 hours starting on Friday 21 January 2011 and ending on Sunday 23 January 2011
- iii. 2200 hours and 0500 hours starting on Sunday 23 January 2011 and ending on Friday 28 January 2011
- iv. 2200 hours and 0700 hours starting on Friday 28 January 2011 and ending on Sunday 30 January 2011
- v. 2200 hours and 0500 hours starting on Sunday 30 January 2011 and ending on Monday 31 January 2011

However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue overnight until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

“the slip road” means the exit slip road leading from the eastbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 12.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
