ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A46 Trunk Road (Binley, Coventry) (Temporary
Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011**

Made - - - - - 3rd May 2011

Coming into force - - - 10th May 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road (“the A46”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road at Binley near Coventry should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A46 Trunk Road (Binley, Coventry) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 10th May 2011.

2. In this Order –

“Binley Roundabout” means the circulatory carriageway of the A46 at its roundabout junction with the A428 at Binley;

“the first length of trunk road” means the northbound and southbound carriageways of the A46 between its roundabout junction with B4082 and Binley Roundabout;

“the second length of trunk road” means the northbound and southbound carriageways of the A46 between Binley Roundabout and a point 1800 metres south of that roundabout;

“the works period” means the period starting at 2000 hours on Sunday 15th May 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the first length of trunk road or the second length of trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on Binley Roundabout.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.
