ROAD TRAFFIC

The A38 Trunk Road (Willington) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - *17th May 2011*
Coming into force - - *24th May 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A38 Trunk Road (“the A38”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and one of those connecting roads, near Willington in the County Derbyshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A38 Trunk Road (Willington) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 24th May 2011.

2. In this Order:

| “Toyota Roundabout” | means the A38/A50/B5008 roundabout junction, north of Willington; |
| “the trunk road” | means –

(i) the northbound carriageway of the A38 from its junction with the A5132 to its junction with the slip road leading from Toyota Roundabout; and

(ii) the southbound carriageway of the A38 from its junction with the slip road leading to Toyota Roundabout to its junction with the A5132; |
| “the slip road” | means the slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the A38 from Toyota Roundabout; |

“the works period” means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Tuesday 31st May 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the trunk road or the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable in uniform;
- (c) being used in connection with the said works; or
- (d) proceeding in the trunk road to or from premises which are accessible for that vehicle from, and only from, that road.
