**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A46 Trunk Road (Evesham, Worcestershire) (Temporary  
Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

*Made* - - - - 20th May 2011

*Coming into force* - - 27th May 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road (“the A46”), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road, south of Evesham, in the County of Worcestershire should be restricted or prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A46 Trunk Road (Evesham, Worcestershire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 27th May 2011.

2. In this Order –

“the roundabout”	means the circulatory carriageway of the A46 at its roundabout junction with the A4184 Cheltenham Road;
"the works period"	means the period starting at 00:01 hours on Wednesday 1st June 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 7 and 8, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour in A46 from a point 500 metres south to a point 500 metres east of the roundabout.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 7 and 8, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the roundabout.

5. Subject as mentioned in articles 7 and 8, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle entering the roundabout from the westbound carriageway of the A46 to make a right turn.

6. Subject as mentioned in articles 7 and 8, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle entering the roundabout from the A4184 Cheltenham Road to make a right turn.

7. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any pedestrian to enter or proceed in the footway adjacent to the roundabout.

8. The provisions of articles 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

9. The provisions of:

- (a) articles 3, 4, 5 and 6 shall not apply to any vehicle –
  - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
  - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
- (b) articles 4, 5 and 6 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works; and
- (c) article 7 shall not apply to –
  - (i) any pedestrian engaged in police, fire brigade or ambulance activities;
  - (ii) any pedestrian acting under the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
  - (iii) personnel engaged in the said works.
