**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Visit by The
President of the United States of America) (Revocation)
Regulations 2011**

Made at 16.55 hours - 24th May 2011

Coming into force - - with immediate effect

The Secretary of State has deemed it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of central London, by reason of a visit by The President of the United States of America that was scheduled to take place during the period 24th and 26th May 2011.

The timetable of arrangements for this visit having now changed, the Secretary of State no longer deems it to be appropriate to restrict flying in accordance with the previous arrangements and makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009(a).

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Visit by The President of the United States of America) (Revocation) Regulations 2011 and come into force with immediate effect.

2. The following Regulations are revoked—

- (a) Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Visit by The President of the United States of America) Regulations 2011(b); and
- (b) The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Visit by the President of the United States of America) (Amendment) Regulations 2011(c).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations revoke the instruments which imposed restrictions on flying in relation to the Visit of The President of the United States of America, the originally envisaged timetable for that visit having been superseded.
