**The A36 Trunk Road (Black Dog Hill, Near Frome) (Temporary
Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011**

<i>Made</i>	- - - -	<i>31st May 2011</i>
<i>Coming into force</i>	- -	<i>4th June 2011</i>

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A36 Trunk Road (“the A36”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road at Black Dog Hill in the District of Mendip in the County of Somerset and in Wiltshire should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the A36 Trunk Road (Black Dog Hill, Near Frome) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 4th June 2011.

2. In this Order –

“the A36” means the A36 at Black Dog Hill, near Frome, from its junction with the A361 roundabout, south of Beckington, to the centre of its junction with the A3098;

“the works” mean resurfacing;

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 6th June 2011 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to an article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the A36.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on the A36 whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that road are displayed.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes; or
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable.

6. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
