ROAD TRAFFIC

The A38 Trunk Road (Landrake, Cornwall) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - *15th June 2011*

Coming into force - - *18th June 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A38 Trunk Road (“the A38”), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road at Landrake in Cornwall should be prohibited and restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A38 Trunk Road (Landrake, Cornwall) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 18th June 2011.

2. In this Order –

“the A38” means the A38 at Landrake from a point 60 metres east of the centre of its junction with Tideford Road to a point 135 metres east of the centre of its junction with New Road Terrace;

“the works” mean maintenance works including the refurbishment of Landrake Footbridge;

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 20th June 2011 or any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 20th June 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the A38.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person, shall, during a works period, enter or proceed on the pedestrian footbridge at Landrake and the footpath under that footbridge.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable.

6. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
