**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A5 Trunk Road (Tamworth, Staffordshire) (Slip Roads)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

*Made - - - - 20th June 2011*

*Coming into force - - 27th June 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road (“the A5) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on seven of those connecting roads, at Tamworth in the County of Staffordshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Tamworth, Staffordshire) (Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 27th June 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the works period” means the period starting at 22.00 hours on Monday 4th July 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the slip road leading -

- (a) to the westbound carriageway of the A5 from Ventura Park Road roundabout;
- (b) from the westbound carriageway of the A5 to Ventura Park Road roundabout;
- (c) to the eastbound carriageway of the A5 from Ventura Park Road roundabout;
- (d) from and to the westbound carriageway of the A5 to and from the B5404/B5080 Watling Street roundabout (Centurian Junction); and

---

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1

---

(e) from and to the eastbound carriageway of the A5 to and from the B5080 Pennine Way roundabout (Centurian Junction).

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle –

(a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;

(b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or

(c) being used in connection with the said works.
