



- (a) 100 metres northwest of the northwestern kerb line of Conington Turn leading from Conington village, and
- (b) 525 metres northwest of the centre point of the High Street overbridge at Junction 27 Fenstanton;

“works” mean carriageway resurfacing and road marking refreshment, kerb replacement and drainage works;

“a works period” means a period of –

- (a) 9 hours starting at 21.00 hours on Thursday 14th July 2011 or on any subsequent day (other than a Friday, Saturday or Sunday),
- (b) 8 hours starting at 22.00 hours on Friday 15th July 2011 or on any subsequent Friday, or
- (c) 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Saturday 16th and Sunday 17th July 2011 or on any subsequent Saturday or Sunday,

until the works have been completed;

“the works period” means the period starting at 00.01 hours on Wednesday 27th July 2011 and ending when the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 5 no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in –

- (a) a slip road or a first lay-by, during a works period, or
- (b) a second lay-by, during the works period.

**4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs.

**5.** Nothing in article 3 shall apply to a vehicle –

- (a) being used for, or in connection with, the works or traffic officer purposes,
- (b) being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes, or
- (c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform;
