**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A27 Trunk Road (Warblington Interchange – Fishbourne Roundabout) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

*Made* - - - - *4th July 2011*  
*Coming into force* - - *23rd July 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A27 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that road and on some of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A27 Trunk Road (Warblington Interchange – Fishbourne Roundabout) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 23rd July 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A27 Trunk Road between Chichester in the County of West Sussex and Havant in the County of Hampshire;

“the first length of carriageway” means the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road between the “off” slip road at Warblington Interchange (A259) and Fishbourne roundabout (A259);

“the second length of carriageway” means the westbound carriageway of the trunk road between Fishbourne roundabout (A259) and the “on” slip road at Warblington Interchange (A259);

“a slip road” means –

- (i) the road leading from the A259 (Havant Road) to the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road at Warblington Interchange, or
- (ii) the road leading to the A259 (Havant Road) from the westbound carriageway of the trunk road at Warblington Interchange;

“works” means road marking and road stud renewal work on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 25th July 2011 or on any subsequent day until 22nd January 2013.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the first length of carriageway, the second length of carriageway or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. Nothing in article 3 above shall apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
