ROAD TRAFFIC

The M1 Motorway and the M62 Motorway (Lofthouse Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No.2) Order 2011

Made - - - - - *7th July 2011*

Coming into force - - - - - *17th July 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M1 Motorway, the M62 Motorway and connecting roads, in the District of Leeds in the County of West Yorkshire, is satisfied that traffic on those motorways and some of those connecting roads should be prohibited because carriageway surfacing and lighting renewal works are proposed to be executed thereon.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M1 Motorway and the M62 Motorway (Lofthouse Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No.2) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 17th July 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the M1” means the M1 Motorway at Junction 42 (Lofthouse Interchange);

“the M62” means the M62 Motorway at Junction 29 (Lofthouse Interchange);

“the roundabout” means the circulatory carriageway of Lofthouse Interchange Roundabout (M62 Junction 29/M1 Junction 42);

“a slip road” means any of the following slip roads:

(i) the M1 northbound and southbound entry and exit slip roads, and

(ii) the M62 eastbound and westbound entry and exit slip roads;

“the works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 18th July 2011 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the roundabout or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for traffic officer purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform.
