ROAD TRAFFIC

The A2 Trunk Road (Cobham Junction, Londonbound Exit Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - *18th July 2011*

Coming into force - - *6th August 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A2 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on one of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A2 Trunk Road (Cobham Junction, Londonbound Exit Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 6th August 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A2 Trunk Road in the County of Kent;

“the slip road” means the road leading from the Londonbound carriageway of the trunk road at Cobham Junction (Brewers Road);

“works” mean street lighting and cabling work on the trunk road; and

“the works period” means the period starting on Monday 8th August 2011 and ending on 5th February 2013.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
