ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A1 Trunk Road (Wyboston Lakes Junction and Southoe)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

Made - - - - *15th August 2011*

Coming into force - - *22nd August 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1 Trunk Road (“the A1”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on that road and on one of those connecting roads in the Counties of Bedfordshire and Cambridgeshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A1 Trunk Road (Wyboston Lakes Junction and Southoe) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 22nd August 2011.

2. In this Order -

“central reservation” means that part of the trunk road which separates the carriageway to be used by traffic moving in one direction from the carriageway which is to be used by traffic moving in the opposite direction;

“works” mean safety barrier maintenance, drainage and weed spraying;

“a works period” means a period of 9 hours starting at 21:00 hours on Wednesday 24th August 2011, or on any subsequent day (other than a Friday, Saturday or Sunday), until the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed -

- (i) in the northbound entry slip road of the A1 from the A428 at Wyboston Lakes Junction, or
- (ii) through the gap in the central reservation opposite its junction with the A1 and Bell Lane, Southoe.

4. The provisions of article 2 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the works, or for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes.
