**The Allocation and Transfer of Proceedings (Amendment No. 2)  
Order 2011**

*Coming into force in accordance with article 1*

The Lord Chancellor, after consulting the Lord Chief Justice, makes the following Order in exercise of powers conferred by section 92(6) of and Part 1 of Schedule 11 to the Children Act 1989(a).

**Citation and Commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Allocation and Transfer of Proceedings (Amendment No. 2) Order 2011 and comes into force—

- (a) in respect of Chorley County Court, on 12th September 2011;
- (b) in respect of Rawtenstall County Court and Shrewsbury County Court, on 3rd October 2011.

**Revocation of Jurisdiction**

2. Chorley County Court, Rawtenstall County Court and Shrewsbury County Court shall cease to be family hearing centres.

**Amendments to the Allocation and Transfer of Proceedings Order 2008**

3. The Allocation and Transfer of Proceedings Order 2008(b) shall be amended by deleting the entries in Schedule 1 (classes of county court) to that Order relating to:

- (a) Chorley County Court;
- (b) Rawtenstall County Court; and
- (c) Shrewsbury County Court.
