ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A11 Trunk Road (B1112 Icklingham to B1106 Elveden,
Suffolk) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

Made - - - 26th August 2011

Coming into force - - 2nd September 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A11 Trunk Road (“the A11”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road in the County of Suffolk should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A11 Trunk Road (B1112 Icklingham to B1106 Elveden, Suffolk) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 2nd September 2011.

2. In this Order –

“the trunk road” means the A11 between the centre line of its junctions with the B1112 Icklingham and the B1106 Elveden;

“lay-by” means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b); and in this definition “carriageway” means a way constituting or comprised in a trunk road (other than a cycle track) over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a surface suitable for the exercise of that right;

“works” mean carriageway resurfacing, gully emptying and vegetation clearance;

“the works period” means the period starting at 00.01 hours on Friday 9th September 2011 and ending when the works have been completed;

“a works period” means a period of 9 hours starting at 21.00 hours on Friday 9th September 2011 or on any subsequent day until the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5 no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in –

(b) S.I. 2002/3113; Part I.

- (a) the trunk road, during a works period, or
- (b) any lay-by adjacent to the trunk road, during the works period.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to a vehicle –

- (a) being used for, or in connection with, the works or for traffic officer purposes,
- (b) being used for police, fire and rescue authority, or ambulance purposes,
- (c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform, or
- (d) requiring access to properties which are accessible from, and only from, the trunk road.
