**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A3 Trunk Road (A287 Junction, Hindhead) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

*Made* - - - - *30th August 2011*

*Coming into force* - - *17th September 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A3 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited a length of that road and on some of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A3 Trunk Road (A287 Junction, Hindhead) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 17th September 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the ‘old’ A3 Trunk Road at Hindhead in the County of Surrey;

“the length of trunk road” means the trunk road between its junction with Royal Huts Avenue and a point 420 metres east of that junction at Hindhead;

“a side road” means –

- (i) the northern section of the A287 (Tilford Road) at its junction with the trunk road at Hindhead, or
- (ii) the southern section of the A287 (Hindhead Road) at its junction with the trunk road at Hindhead;

“works” mean mini roundabout construction and all associated work on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 2000 hours on Monday 19th September 2011 or on any subsequent day until 16th March 2013.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of trunk road, to enter the trunk road from a side road or to enter a side road from the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;

- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes; or
- (e) a vehicle proceeding in the length of trunk road to or from premises accessible from, and only from, that road, to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs.
