ROAD TRAFFIC

The A30 Trunk Road (Avers Junction, Redruth, and Treswithian Junction, Camborne) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - 25 January 2011
Coming into force - - 29 January 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A30 Trunk Road (“the A30”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on four of those connecting roads at the Avers and Treswithian Junctions in Cornwall should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A30 Trunk Road (Avers Junction, Redruth, and Treswithian Junction, Camborne) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 29 January 2011.

2. In this Order –

“the slip roads” mean (i) the eastbound and westbound exit slip roads at the A30 Avers Junction, Redruth; and (ii) the eastbound and westbound exit slip roads at the A30 Treswithian Junction, Camborne;

“the works” mean highway improvement works;

“the works period” means the period starting at 00.01 hours on Tuesday 1 February 2011 or any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Tuesday 1 February 2011 or any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the slip roads.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip roads.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

(a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;

(b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable.

6. The provisions of article 4 shall not apply to a vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works or for traffic officer purposes.
