ROAD TRAFFIC

The A259 Trunk Road (Near Rye) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - *12th September 2011*

Coming into force - - *1st October 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A259 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on lengths of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A259 Trunk Road (Near Rye) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 1st October 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A259 Trunk Road near Rye in the County of East Sussex;

“the first length of trunk road” means the trunk road between points 30 metres northeast and 30 metres northwest of Star Level Crossing near Rye;

“the second length of trunk road” means the trunk road between points 30 metres north and 30 metres south of East Guldeford Level Crossing near Rye;

“works” means level crossing work on the trunk road;

“a first works period” means a period of 12 hours starting at 0800 hours on Sunday 9th October 2011 or on any subsequent Sunday until 18th December 2011; and

“a second works period” means a period of 8 hours starting at 2300 hours on Tuesday 15th November 2011 or on any subsequent day other than a Friday, Saturday or Sunday until 22nd December 2011.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a first works period or a second works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the first length of trunk road or the second length of trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

(a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;

(b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;

- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes; or
- (e) a vehicle proceeding in the first length of trunk road or the second length of trunk road to or from premises accessible from, and only from, that road to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs.
