ROAD TRAFFIC

The M1 Motorway (Junction 28 to Junction 29) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2011

Made - - - - 19th September 2011

Coming into force - - 26th September 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M1 Motorway (“the M1”), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that motorway, in the County of Derbyshire, should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M1 Motorway (Junction 28 to Junction 29) (Temporary 50 Miles Per hour Speed Restriction) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 26th September 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the motorway” means –

- (i) the northbound carriageway of the M1 between a point 1254 metres south and a point 1616 metres north of the centreline of the B6026 Huthwaite Lane underbridge; and
- (ii) the southbound carriageway of the M1 between a point 1400 metres north and a point 1254 metres south of the centreline of the B6026 Huthwaite Lane underbridge;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Sunday 2nd October 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the motorway.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle -

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade, ambulance or special forces purposes; or
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.
