

- (d) from the tip of the nosing of the exit slip road at Junction 9 to a point 3450 metres south of that slip road, and
- (e) 2200 metres north and 800 metres north of its junction with the A1000 Hertford Road at Junction 6;

“the slip road” means the A1(M) northbound exit slip road at Junction 10;

“a slip road” means the A1(M) –

- (a) northbound exit slip road at Junction 10,
- (a) southbound exit and entry slip roads at Junction 9, and
- (b) southbound exit slip road at Junction 8;

“works” mean the replacement of road signs;

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 10th October 2011 or on any subsequent day, other than a Saturday or a Sunday, until the works have been completed;

and a reference to a junction is a reference to the centreline of that junction and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the northbound carriageway, the southbound carriageway, or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes, or to a vehicle falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations **(a)**.
