**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A27 Trunk Road (Lewes Road, Near Eastbourne)  
(Temporary Speed Restrictions) Order 2011**

*Made*        -   -   -   -                      *26th September 2011*  
*Coming into force*   -   -                      *15th October 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A27 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A27 Trunk Road (Lewes Road, Near Eastbourne) (Temporary Speed Restrictions) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 15th October 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A27 Trunk Road (Lewes Road) near Eastbourne in the County of East Sussex;

“the length of trunk road” means the trunk road between points 1000 metres west and 605 metres east of the centreline of Folkington Road west of Polegate;

“works” mean resurfacing and road marking work on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 10½ hours starting at 1930 hours on Monday 17th October 2011 or on any subsequent day until 14th April 2013.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding –

- (a) 10 miles per hour on the length of trunk road while traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that length of road are displayed; or
- (b) 40 miles per hour on the length of trunk road while the traffic signs specified in paragraph (a) of this article in relation to that length of road are not displayed.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes and to vehicles falling within regulation
