ROAD TRAFFIC

The A46 Trunk Road (Warwick to Stoneleigh) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - - *23rd September 2011*

Coming into force - - - - - *30th September 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road (“the A46”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road and some of those connecting roads, between Warwick and Stoneleigh in the County of Warwickshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A46 Trunk Road (Warwick to Stoneleigh) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 30th September 2011.

2. In this Order:

| “the trunk road” | means – |
| | (i) the northbound carriageway of the A46 from its junction with the slip road leading to its roundabout junction with the A4177 and A425 at Warwick to its junction with the slip road leading from Stoneleigh Road, northwest of Stoneleigh; and |
| | (ii) the southbound carriageway of the A46 from its junction with the slip road leading to Stoneleigh Road, northwest of Stoneleigh to its junction with the slip road leading from its roundabout junction with the A4177 and A425 at Warwick; |
| “a slip road” | means any slip road leading to or from the trunk road; |
| “the works period” | means the period starting at 21.00 hours on Monday 3rd October 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed; |

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes,
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
