**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A42 Trunk Road (Breedon on the Hill, Leicestershire)  
(Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011**

*Made* - - - - *26th September 2011*  
*Coming into force* - - *3rd October 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A42 Trunk Road (“the A42”), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road, near Breedon on the Hill in the County of Leicestershire, should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A42 Trunk Road (Breedon on the Hill, Leicestershire) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 3rd October 2011.

2. In this Order:

- “the first length of trunk road” means the northbound carriageway of the A42 between points 2100 metres and 900 metres south of the centreline of the A453 overbridge (Junction 14);
- “the second length of trunk road” means the northbound carriageway of the A42 between points 900 metres and 700 metres south of the centreline of the A453 overbridge (Junction 14);
- “the works period” means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Thursday 6th October 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the first length of trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on lengths of the second length of trunk road, whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on those lengths of road are displayed.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade, ambulance or special forces purposes; or
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.
