ROAD TRAFFIC

The A36 Trunk Road (Churchill Way West, Salisbury) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - 4th October 2011

Coming into force - - 10th October 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A36 Trunk Road ("the A36"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road at in Salisbury should be prohibited and restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the A36 Trunk Road (Churchill Way West, Salisbury) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 10th October 2011.
 - 2. In this Order -

"the slip road means the northbound exit slip road of the A36 at Churchill Way West, Salisbury;

"a works period" means a period of 9½ hours starting at 20.00 hours on Wednesday 12th October 2011 or any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 4, no person shall, during a works period cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.
- **4.**The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to
 - (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or a traffic officer in uniform;
 - (c) a vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works.
