**The A27 Trunk Road (Firle - Selmeston) (50 Miles Per Hour
Speed Limit) Order 2011**

Made - - - - - *10th October 2011*

Coming into force - *3rd November 2011*

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 84(1)(a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A27 Trunk Road (Firle - Selmeston) (50 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 3rd November 2011.

2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the length of the A27 Trunk Road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

SCHEDULE

Length of the Trunk Road subject to a speed limit of 50 miles per hour

Both carriageways of the A27 Trunk Road east of Lewes in the County of East Sussex between points 16 metres east of the centre of Ripe Lane, Firle and 745 metres west of its junction with The Street at Selmeston, a total distance of approximately 1890 metres.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order imposes a 50 miles per hour speed limit on a length of the A27 Trunk Road, east of Lewes in the County of East Sussex as described in the Schedule and supersedes a temporary Order to this effect.
