ROAD TRAFFIC

The A5 Trunk Road (Cannock, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - *7th October 2011*
Coming into force - - *14th October 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road (“the A5”), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road, at Cannock, in the County of Staffordshire, should be prohibited and restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Cannock, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 14th October 2011.

2. In this Order:

“Longford Roundabout” means the circulatory carriageway of the A5 at its roundabout junction with the A4601;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Friday 21st October 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in Longford Roundabout or the trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave Longford Roundabout at its junctions with the A4601.

5. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on lengths of Longford Roundabout, whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that length of road are displayed.

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

7. The provisions of:

(a) articles 3, 4 and 5 shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;

(b) article 5 shall not apply to any vehicle being used for special forces purposes; and

(c) articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
