**The A14 Trunk Road (Junction 57 Nacton Interchange, Ipswich,
Suffolk) Eastbound (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed
Restriction) Order 2011**

Made - - - - *24th October 2011*

Coming into force - - *31st October 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A14 Trunk Road (“the A14”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road in the County of Suffolk should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A14 Trunk Road (Junction 57 Nacton Interchange, Ipswich, Suffolk) Eastbound (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 31st October 2011.

2. In this Order –

“tip of the nosing” means, as indicated by the markings on the carriageway, the first point where an entry slip road joins the carriageway of the trunk road.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below no person shall, during a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 7th November 2011 or on any subsequent day until works to re-grade the slope on the eastbound verge have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the A14 from a point 210 metres east of the centre point of the Alnesbourn Priory Accommodation overbridge to a point 575 metres east of the tip of the nosing of the eastbound entry slip road from Junction 57 Nacton Interchange.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes or to a vehicle falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(b) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
