ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A38 Trunk Road (Egginton, Derbyshire) (Temporary
Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

Made - - - - *17th October 2011*
Coming into force - - *24th October 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A38 Trunk Road (“the A38”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road and one of those connecting roads, near Egginton in the County of Derbyshire, should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) , and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A38 Trunk Road (Egginton, Derbyshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 24th October 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the first length of trunk road” means the southbound carriageway of the A38 from a point 1470 metres north of the centre point of its roundabout junction with the A50/B5008 (Toyota Interchange) to its junction with the slip road leading from the A5132 The Castle Way;

“the second length of trunk road” means the southbound carriageway of the A38 from its junction with the slip road leading to its roundabout junction with the A50/B5008 (Toyota Interchange) to its junction with the slip road leading from the A5132 The Castle Way;

“a slip road” means the slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the A38 from its roundabout junction with the A50/B5008 (Toyota Interchange);

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

“the works period”

means the period starting at 22:00 hours on Monday 31st October 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the first length of trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the second length of trunk road or a slip road.

5. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave any side road leading to or from the second length trunk road;

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

7. The provisions of:

(a) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle being used for special forces purposes;

(b) articles 3, 4 and 5 shall not apply to any vehicle –

(i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or

(ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;

(c) articles 4 and 5 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works; and

(d) article 4 shall not apply to any vehicle proceeding in the trunk road to or from premises which are accessible for that vehicle from, and only from, that road.
