ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A38 Trunk Road (Burton upon Trent, Staffordshire)
(Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2011**

Made - - - - 3 January 2011

Coming into force - - 10 January 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A38 Trunk Road (“the A38”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road between Stretton and Shobnall, at Burton upon Trent in the County of Staffordshire should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A38 Trunk Road (Burton upon Trent, Staffordshire) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 10 January 2011.

2. In this Order –

“the trunk road” means the southbound carriageway of the A38 from the centreline of Hillfield Lane Bridge at Stretton to the centreline of Outwoods footbridge at Shobnall;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 17 January 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to any vehicle –

(a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or

(b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.
