**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The M6 and M6 Toll Motorways (Coleshill, Warwickshire)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

*Made* - - - - *14th November 2011*

*Coming into force* - *21st November 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M6 Motorway (“the M6”), the M6 Toll Motorway (“the M6 Toll”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of those motorways and on two of those connecting roads near Coleshill, in the County of Warwickshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the M6 and M6 Toll Motorways (Coleshill, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 21st November 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the first length of motorway” means the northbound carriageway of the M6 from its junction with the M6 Toll at Junction 3a to its junction with the entry slip road from the A446 roundabout at Junction 4;

“the second length of motorway” means the northbound carriageway of the M6 Toll from its junction with the link road leading to the northbound carriageway of the M42 at Junction 9 to its junction with the entry slip road leading from the A4097 (Junction T1);

“the slip road” means the slip road leading from the northbound carriageway of the M6 to its roundabout junction with the A446 at Junction 4;

“the link road” means the link road leading from the northbound carriageway of the M6 at Junction 4 to the southbound carriageway of the M42;

“the works period”

means the period starting at 22:00 hours on Saturday 26th November 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the first length of motorway, the second length of motorway, the slip road or the link road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or traffic officer in uniform, or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works or by a traffic officer in uniform.
